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HOBIC First for MedShare

<Cambridge, Ontario> MedShare announced today, that their electronic nurse charting solution is integrated with the province's HOBIC system.

Health Outcomes for Better Information and Care, or HOBIC, is an initiative of the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care's Information Management and Investment Division. It involves the collection of standardized information from nurses working in acute care, complex continuing care, long-term care and home care settings across Ontario. MedShare is able to collect health outcomes data at the point of care using tablet computers and their proprietary eMotion software, which is then automatically transmitted to the province's central database.

The solution provides evidence-based feedback for visiting nurses in home and community care settings. Together MedShare, Bayshore Home Health and HOBIC developed a real-time integration between the MedShare's EHR repository and the HOBIC database. Nurses are able to access online HOBIC Reports to review client outcomes over the episode of care.

The solution is based on MedShare eMotion software running on tablet computers at the point of care. MedShare "Smart Charts" were used to provide an electronic version of the HOBIC Assessment form. The collection of standardized clinical outcome measures provides valuable information on how well the clients are progressing towards their discharge goals. This allows nursing staff to make more informed care decisions and improve health outcomes.

Helen Holmes of the HOBIC summed it up in an email to the project team, "This is the first home care site live with HOBIC – this is a big milestone for the Program".
